Subject: Limiting Outside Trips and Visitations

As you are aware, we have implemented a Coronavirus (COVID – 19) precaution plan. We have received some new information in which we can utilize to take some more precautions into preventing the entry of the virus in our facility.

We are asking everyone to please limit your trips outside the facility. If you must leave, only do so if it's necessary. Please do not visit any location that is going to have large crowds. Do not visit other senior care facilities, or any place that are considered high risk. Please remember that when you leave the building you have the potential to bring back to your fellow residents the disease. Please remember you may be extremely healthy, but others are not.

We are still having questions about activities and transportation, so we want to be clear. Every event, activity and all transportation has been suspended until further notice. If you need help with ordering your groceries, please let us know. For those that cannot order groceries, please utilize Apple Annie's. A staff member can open the door for you anytime Monday through Friday from the hours of 7am to 3pm and we can charge what you need to your monthly bill. We will not be opening it for our normal times as we wanted to make it more available to you all. We have added to our stock and have added new stock for you, after you have done that, if you still need some essential supplies, you can give us a list and we'll make a trip out to the store for you.

We are so sorry for the inconvenience this has caused but right now our foremost priority is the health and well-being of all our residents and staff members.
