Subject: Update on the current COVID Protocols

We still have not received any news from our employee. Due to this being a holiday week, we may not know until next week. We will inform you as soon as we have the information.

We have also spoken to the Executive Committee of St. Anne's Board of Directors and have decided to stay the course with our protocols and follow Governor Kemps Executive Order to Shelter in Place until July 15th and will continue to closely monitor the current rise in the COVID virus via the CDC and Georgia Department of Public Health.

Starting next Wednesday, July 8th we will have family visitation from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. outside in the courtyard. We plan to do this every Tuesday and Wednesday from here on out until we restart our reopening plan. We have purchased tents to ensure the entire area is shaded and covered in case of rain.

Visitors will need to walk around the southside of the building (by the raised garden beds) to the courtyard and stop by the staff manned table (near the Gazebo) and have their temperature taken before visiting. All visitors must wear a face covering while on the grounds, if a visitor comes without a face covering, they will not be allowed in the visitation area. Residents will need to come down in the dining room and check in with a staff member stationed near the doorway next to the piano.

Each visitor will only be able to visit for 30 minutes so that we can accommodate everyone that wishes to visit. To ensure that we can practice safe social distancing under the tents, we must limit it to two visitors per resident for each 30 minute session. We can only safely accommodate up to 30 people at a time under the tents (this includes residents). Therefore, if we reach the limit of people that can fit safely under the tent, visitors will be asked to wait near the sign-in table and residents will be asked to wait in the dining room until a visit session ends. You will then be ushered to the visitation area by a staff member.

We are very sorry in having to delay our reopening plans. We did not make this decision lightly. Please know that we are working around the clock to find ways to ensure that we will not have to delay them in the future.
