Subject: COVID-19 Virus Update

We were informed yesterday that the two employees who were experiencing COVID symptoms tested positive for the virus. Both employees have been instructed by the Georgia Department of Public Health to quarantine for 14 days and they must be retested and present us with a negative COVID test before coming back to work.

One employee has not been in the building since June 23rd. The other employee was sent home July 11th. That day we immediately sanitized any area in which they came in contact and immediately sprayed those areas as well. Since then we have thoroughly sanitized the entire facility and have maintained our regular anti-viral spraying schedule on top of what was performed on the 11th.

Currently there are no other staff members or residents exhibiting signs or symptoms. It is encouraging to know that our strict infection control protocols and liberal use of PPE has helped reduce our risk of the spread COVID-19. That is why it is important for us to continue to follow our current COVID protocols. We will remain under these protocols until further notice.
