Subject: Soft Reopening of the Terrace

Please note the schedule below:

- There will be no family visitation the week of July 27th.
- On Monday, July 27th the furniture in common areas will be put back into place.
- Our new Viral Sign equipment will be installed next Tuesday, July 28th. We will be scanning all employees, caregivers, contractors and residents the first week.
- On Monday, August 3rd we will have family visitation Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. We will be sanitizing the building every day after visitation.
- Starting Monday, August 3rd if a resident has an outside appointment they will need to be scanned upon return to the building. If their scan is clear they will not need to be quarantined.
- If a resident wants to leave with a family member or a friend, they will need to be picked up at the front entrance if after visiting hours. They will be scanned upon their return to the building.
- As we work with the new system and vet any issues that may arise, we will we adjust the visiting times to a more normal schedule.
- Visitors will still be required to wear a mask in the building.
- All residents who leave the premises should wear a mask.

We are excited about this new tool in our fight against the COVID virus. In August we will be opening some of our inside activities that do not require an outside person coming into to the building. My staff and I will continue to work diligently in our soft reopening of the facility. The COVID-19 virus is still very fluid situation. Please be aware our schedule may change.
