We have all been hearing about the daily number of positive COVID cases that continues to rise in our country, our state, and our community. We recognize the perils of the virus, as well as the perils that a lockdown can cause in our Terrace community. We want to keep our building open to families and we are asking for your help in the following ways to achieve this goal.

Starting on Thursday, November 19, 2020 the following will be put in place:

- Visiting hours will change to 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. seven days a week.
- You will not be able to use the common areas, such as the parlor, 3rd & 4th floor card rooms and community room. We ask that you do not congregate in the lobby areas.
- The dining room will be closed. Meal deliveries will begin at 4:30 p.m. Monday -Saturday and at noon on Sunday.
- If you leave the property for any reason you will need to be quarantine in your apartment for 10 days upon your return. A negative COVID test could shorten your quarantine time.
- We strongly advise you to wear a face covering when you are out of your apartment. We will provide one face covering for each resident.
- All group activities such as exercise, bingo, Morning Prayer, movies, hand & foot, Sunday Church Stream, etc. are cancelled for the present time until further notice

We have had remarkable success in impeding the virus and want to continue to do so. Thanks to all of you for your patience and support during these difficult days. Thanksgiving will be different for ALL of us this year. Our spirit of gratitude endures.
