Subject: COVID-19

On the afternoon of January 2, 2021, I was notified that one of our residents had tested positive for COVID-19. This resident has not come out of her apartment except to go for a COVID test. This resident does have two private caregivers that are from an agency. This agency only has two clients at the Terrace. One of the private caregivers tested positive for COVID-19 on December 27th, the last day this caregiver was at the Terrace was on December 25th.

The agency has shared their contact tracing with me, the Terrace has done contract tracing as well, and no other staff or resident at the Terrace has been exposed from this caregiver to our knowledge.

It has come to our attention that if you have been exposed to COVID or been off the property you should quarantine for 4 days before receiving a COVID test. We are on the list at CVS to receive the COVID vaccine. We do not have a date yet as to when we will receive the vaccine.

I will keep you apprised as other information arises.
