Subject: COVID-19 (Delta Variant)

Starting Wednesday, August 4th some of our current curriculum will be put on hold for at least a month, or longer.

- We will only be providing transportation to medical appointments. Using our current bus schedule. All other outside trips and activities have been cancelled until further notice.
- We will continue to provide in-house events such as dinner, exercise, morning prayer, hand & food, etc. In the next few days, we will put out a modified schedule and adjust info on the lobby TVs to reflect these changes.
- We encourage you to limit your time outside of the building while COVID cases are so high.
- The guest room will be closed to all outside guests.
- The common areas will remain open for resident use only.
- The beauty shop and Apple Annie's will remain open.
- Visitation will be limited from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm seven days a week. If you have guests, they are only allowed in your apartment, but not in the common areas. Guests will be not allowed at any in-house event or activity.
- **Unless** you experience COVID symptoms there **will not** be any **quarantine** at this time. But if you do not feel well, have a fever, cough, or have a loss of smell or taste, please quarantine in your apartment, but don't forget to let us know.

My staff and I realize how disappointing it is to reinstate some of our 2020 COVID precautions, but currently, this is the safest avenue for us to take. Please note that as we monitor the situation, things can change, and we may have to modify or adjust these precautions. We will keep you posted on any changes we must make.

As you know the vaccines are supposed to last for at least 6 months. If you received your vaccine at the Terrace, then you received your 2nd dose on March 2nd which means September 2nd will be our 6-month mark. For some of you your 6 months may end in August, depending on when you received your vaccine. There has been talk of booster vaccines, but I have no information when or if boosters will be available or recommended. We will keep you posted as we become aware.
