Re: **COVID Update**

All staff members that were tested on Friday came back negative, however there is a flu bug that has been going through the staff. Those with any symptoms are to stay home until they are without fever for 24 hours without the aid of medication. We have been a little short staffed in recent weeks due to this, but this week almost everyone has returned to work.

This weekend a resident was feeling ill and had to be transported to the hospital. We were informed this morning that the resident has tested positive for COVID. Also, yesterday we were informed of another resident that was exposed to someone with COVID last week, and this morning that a Personal Care employee exposed some other residents. Those exposed will be tested as soon as it can be arranged. We will keep everyone updated on the test results and on the two residents currently in the hospital.

To help us combat the virus, it is crucial for everyone to wear their masks properly, wash your hands regularly, maintain safe social distancing and limit visits in your apartment. Please limit all visitations to a minimum. As of now we are not closing visitation, but the situation remains fluid.
