Re: **COVID Update and KN95 Masks**

Yesterday we were made aware of a resident testing positive for COVID. The resident is currently in the hospital seeking care. No other resident was a close contact, but we did have one staff member exposed and three others exhibiting symptoms. They are all tested, have been sent home, and are awaiting results. We will keep everyone posted as we gather more information.

Also, this morning staff delivered KN95 masks to every apartment. These have proven to be some of the safest masks to combat COVID. We have also purchased cloth versions of these with filters that are reusable. As soon as they are in, we will be delivering those to every resident as well with directions on how to wash them.

It is crucial for everyone to wear their masks properly, wash your hands regularly, maintain safe social distancing and limit visits in your apartment. Please do not have a family member visit if they have been exposed or are experiencing symptoms. As of now we are not closing visitation, but the situation remains fluid. We will keep everyone updated as we gather more information.
